Advanced Caulking awarded the Small Business Success Award from the Northern Kentucky Chamber of Commerce



Advanced Advice

Stay safe working in the heat this summer! Outdoor operations conducted in hot weather, such as construction can be dangerous. Prevent heat stress by knowing the signs and monitoring yourself & co-workers.

- Block out direct sun/heat sources
- Use cooling fans/rest regularly
- Drink lots of water; 1 cup per 15 min
- Wear lightweight, light colored, loose-fitted clothing
- Avoid alcohol, caffeine or heavy meals
